TRAFFIC REGULATION

VILLAGE OF WATKINS GLEN

PREAMBLE

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Watkins Glen, County of Schuyler, State of New York, pursuant to the provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, does, on June 6, 1977, hereby enact the following Local Law to regulate traffic and parking, standing and stopping upon the highways within the Village of Watkins Glen.

ARTICLE I

WORDS AND PHRASES DEFINED

Section 1. Words and phrases defined.

(a) The words and phrases used in this local law shall for the purpose of this local law have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by Article I of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

(b) The following words and phrases which are not defined by Article I of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section for purposes of the local law of this Village.

1. Curb Line. The prolongation of the lateral line of a curb or, in the absence of a curb, the lateral boundary line of the roadway.

- 2. Official Time Standard. Whenever certain hours are named herein or on traffic control devices they shall mean the time standard which is in current use in this state.
- 3. Public Parking Lot. A plot or parcel of land or building owned and/or leased by this village, not including highways, upon or within which the parking of vehicles is regulated by signs and/or parking meters.

ARTICLE II

TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

Section 20. Authority to install traffic control devices. The Department of Streets of the Village of Watkins Glen shall install and maintain traffic control devices when and as required under the provisions of this local law to make effective the provisions of said local law and may install and maintain such additional traffic control devices as it may deem necessary to regulate, warn or guide traffic under the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York subject to the provisions of Sections 1682 and 1684 of that Law.

ARTICLE IV

TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS

Section 40. Traffic Control Signals not applicable at this time.

ARTICLE V

ONE-WAY ROADWAYS

Section 50. One-way roadways.

- (a) The following highways are hereby designated for one-way traffic in a westerly direction:
 - 1. Sixth Street between Decatur and Franklin Streets.
- (b) The following highways are hereby designated for one-way traffic in an easterly direction:
 - 1. Third Street between Franklin and Decatur Streets.
 - 2. Fifth Street between Franklin and Decatur Streets.
 - 3. Seventh Street between Franklin and Decatur Streets.
- (c) The following streets are hereby designated as one-way Snowmobile Routes:

ARTICLE VI

PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

Section 60. Pedestrian crossings prohibited.

- (a) No pedestrian shall cross Franklin Street from and including First Street to and including South Avenue except within a crosswalk.
- (b) No pedestrian shall cross Fourth Street from and including Magee Street to and including Madison Avenue except within a crosswalk.

ARTICLE VII

TURNING MOVEMENTS

Section 72. Prohibition of U-turns. The turning of vehicles so as to proceed in the opposite direction is hereby prohibited at the following locations:

1. On Franklin Street between Division Street and the Southerly Village Corporate limits.
2. On Fourth Street between Madison Avenue and Magee Street.

ARTICLE VIII

STOP AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS

Section 80. The following intersection is hereby designated as a stop intersection and stop signs shall be erected on entrances thereto as indicated.

ARTICLE IX

SPEED REGULATIONS

Section 90. Maximum Speed limits.

(a) Thirty (30) miles per hour is hereby established as the maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed on or along highways within the corporate limits of this village except on the following highways:

1. North Madison Avenue between its intersection with Partition Street and the Northerly Village line.
2. North Decatur Street between a point 300 feet northerly from and on a line with the Northwestern corner of the Watkins Glen Middle School Building as extended and a point 300 feet Southerly from and on a line with the Southwesterly corner of the Watkins Glen Middle School Building as extended.
3. South Decatur Street between a point 300 feet Northerly from and on a line with the Northwestern corner of the Watkins Glen Elementary School Building as extended and a point 300 feet Southerly from and on a line with the Southerly corner of the Watkins Glen Elementary School Building as extended.

(b) Forty (40) Miles per hour is hereby established as the maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed within the corporate limits of this village on the following highways:

1. North Madison Avenue between its intersection with Partition Street and the Northerly Village line.

(c) Fifteen (15) miles per hour is hereby established as the maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed within the corporate limits of this Village on the following highways, during the school noon hour, school recess, or while children are going to or leaving school during opening or closing hours:

1. North Decatur Street between a point 300 feet Northerly from and on a line with the Northwestern corner of the Watkins Glen Middle School Building as extended and a point 300 feet Southerly from and on a line with the Southwesterly corner of the Watkins Glen Middle School Building as extended.
2. South Decatur Street between a point 300 feet Northerly from and on a line with the Northwestern corner of the Watkins Glen Elementary School Building as extended and a point 300 feet Southerly from and on a line with Southwesterly corner of the Watkins Glen Elementary School Building as extended.

ARTICLE X

PARKING, STANDING AND STOPPING

Section 100. Application of Article. The provisions of this article shall apply except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.

Section 101. All-night parking. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited within this Village between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. on both sides of Franklin Street between Division Street and Tenth Street and on both sides of Fourth Street between Madison Avenue and Magee Street.

Section 102. Parking Prohibited in Designated Locations.

- (a) The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in any of the following locations:
1. On the East side of S. Madison Avenue
 2. On the East side of Monroe St. between Pine Street & Steuben St.
 3. On the East side of Jackson St. between Pine & Steuben Sts.
 4. On the East side of Decatur St. from the Glen Creek Bridge Northerly to Fourth St.
 5. On the North side of Ninth St. between Franklin and Decatur Streets.
 6. On the south side of Ninth St. between Decatur & Porter Sts.
 7. On the south side of Tenth Street between Franklin and Porter Sts.
 8. On the West side of N. Monroe Street between Second and Division Sts.
 9. On the east side of N. Monroe St. between Division and Partition Sts.
 10. On the north side of Second Street between Franklin and Decatur Sts.
 11. On the south side of Eleventh Street from the east curb line of Franklin Street to a point 165 feet Easterly therefrom.
 12. On the south side of Fourth Street between Magee Street and a point 80 feet East of the East curb line of Perry Street.
 13. On the south side of Eighth Street from the East curb line of Franklin Street to a point 136 feet easterly therefrom.
 14. On the south side of Eighth Street from the west curb line of Franklin Street to a point 200 feet westerly therefrom.
 15. On the north side of Eighth Street from the west curb line of Franklin Street to a point 100 feet westerly therefrom.
 16. On the south side of Seventh Street from the east curb line of Franklin Street to a point 76 feet easterly therefrom.
 17. On both sides of Pine Street between a point 50 feet westerly from the west curb line of Franklin Street to Jackson Street.
 18. On the north side of Eighth St. from the East curb line of Franklin to a point 55 feet easterly therefrom.

Section 103. Standing Prohibited in Designated Locations.

- (a) The standing of vehicles is hereby prohibited in any of the following locations:
1. On the north side of Fifteenth Street from the east curb line of Franklin Street to a point 100 feet easterly therefrom.
 2. On the south side of Fifteenth St. from the east curb line of Franklin St. to a point 70 feet easterly therefrom.
 3. On both sides of Fourteenth St. from the east curb line of Franklin St. to a point 50 feet easterly therefrom.
 4. On both sides of Durland Avenue from the east curb line of Franklin St. to a point 50 feet easterly therefrom.
 5. On both sides of Twelfth St. from the east curb line of Franklin St. to a point 50 feet easterly therefrom.
 6. On north side of Eleventh St. from the east curb line of Franklin St. to a point 50 feet easterly therefrom.
 7. On the north side of Tenth Street from the east curb line of Franklin St. to a point 50 feet easterly therefrom.
 8. On the east side of Franklin St. from the north curb line of Tenth St. to a point 60 feet northerly therefrom.
 9. On the west side of Franklin St. from the north curb line of Tenth St. to a point 90 feet northerly therefrom.
 10. On the east side of Franklin St. from the south curb line of Eighth St. to a point 50 feet southerly therefrom.
 11. On the East side of Franklin St. from the north curb line Eighth Street to a point 30 feet northerly therefrom.

 16. On the east side of Franklin St. from the north curb line of Seventh Street to a point 42 feet northerly therefrom.
 17. On the south side of Sixth St. from the east curb line of Franklin St. to a point 86 feet easterly therefrom.

57. On the east side of Franklin St., between a point 105 feet southerly from the prolongation of the south curb line of Division St. to a point 120 feet northerly from the prolongation of the north curb line of Division St.

 3. On the east side of Franklin St. from the north curb line of Ninth St. to a point 50 feet northerly therefrom.
 4. On both sides of Pine St. from the West curb line of Franklin St. to a point 50 feet westerly therefrom.
 5. On the west side of Franklin St. from the north curb line of Pine St. to a point 63 feet northerly therefrom.
 6. On the west side of Franklin St. from the south curb line of Pine St. to a point 44 feet southerly therefrom.
 7. On the east side of Franklin St. from the south curb line of Sixth St. to a point 34 feet southerly therefrom.
 8. On the west side of Franklin St. from the south curb line of Sixth St. to a point 56 feet southerly therefrom.
 9. On the west side of Franklin St. from the north curb line of Sixth St. to a point 60 feet northerly therefrom.

(d) The stopping of vehicles except taxi cabs is hereby prohibited in any of the following locations:

Section 105. Parking Time Limited in Designated Locations.

(a) The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in any of the following locations for a period longer than ten (10) minutes:

1. On the east side of Franklin St. between a point 34 feet southerly from the south curb line of Sixth St. and a point 74 feet southerly from the south curb line of Sixth St.
2. On the west side of Franklin St. between a point 150 feet northerly from the north curb line of Fourth St. and a point 200 feet northerly from the north curb line of Fourth St.

(b) The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in any of the following locations for a period longer than two (2) hours unless otherwise prohibited or restricted by this local law in Art X Sec. 100-101-102, 103-104 or 105A.

Section 105 (Cont.)

1. On both sides of Franklin Street between Division Street and Tenth Street.
2. On both sides of Fourth Street between Madison Ave. and Magee Street.
3. On both sides of Eleventh Street.
4. On both sides of Sixth Street between Franklin Street and the alley between Franklin and Decatur Street.
5. On both sides of Fifth Street between Franklin Street and the alley between Franklin and Decatur Streets.
6. On both sides of Third St. between Franklin Street and the alley between Franklin and Decatur Streets.
7. On the South side of Second Street between a point 31 feet Easterly from the East curb line of Franklin Street to the alley between Franklin and Decatur Streets.

Section 106. Parking prohibited on specified Village Streets for the purpose of cleaning streets, including snow, sand, leaves and other debris.

- (a) The Department of Streets of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York may prohibit parking on specified streets within the village on specified days and at specified hours for the purpose of enabling said Department of Streets to remove snow from said streets so specified. The Department of Streets shall give notice of the prohibition of parking pursuant to this section by publishing notice containing said specifications in the official newspaper of the Village at least twelve (12) hours before such prohibition of parking shall take effect.

ARTICLE XI

PARKING METERS

Section 110. Zones. Not applicable at this time.

ARTICLE XII

REMOVAL AND STORAGE OF VEHICLES

Section 120. Authority to Impound Vehicles.

- (a) When any vehicle is parked or abandoned on any highway within this village during a snowstorm, flood, fire or other public emergency which affects that portion of the public highway upon which said vehicle is parked or abandoned, said vehicle may be removed by the Police Department or the Department of Streets of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York.
- (b) When any vehicle is found Unattended on any highway within this village where said vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic, said vehicle may be removed by the Police Department or the Department of Streets of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York.
- (c) When any vehicle is parked or abandoned on any highway within this village where stopping, standing or parking is prohibited, said vehicle may be removed by the Police Department or Department of Streets of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York.

Section 121. Storage and Charges. After removal of any vehicle as provided in this article, the Police Department or Department of Streets of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York may store such vehicle in a suitable place at the expense of the owner. Such owner, or person in charge of the vehicle may redeem the same upon payment to the Village of Watkins Glen, New York of the amount of all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal. Removal charges shall not exceed \$25.00 dollars and storage charges shall not exceed \$3.00 dollars per day or fraction thereof.

Section 122. Notice of Removal. The Police Department of the Department of Streets of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York shall without delay report the removal and the disposition of any vehicle removed as provided in this article to the Police Department of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York and it shall be the duty of such Police Dept. to ascertain to the extent possible the owner of the vehicle or person having same in charge and notify him of the removal and disposition of such vehicle and of the amount which will be required to redeem same.

ARTICLE XIII

TRUCK EXCLUSIONS

Section 131. Trucks over five (5) tons excluded. Trucks in excess of 5 tons are hereby excluded from the following highways within this Village:

1. On Decatur Street between its intersection with Fairground Lane & Fourth Street.

Section 132. The regulations established in this article shall not be construed to prevent the delivery or pick-up of merchandise or other property along the highways from which such vehicles and combinations are otherwise excluded.

ARTICLE XXXI

REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

Section 310. Ordinances repealed; general. All prior ordinances or parts of ordinances of this village regulating traffic are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.

Section 311. Ordinances repealed; specific. The following ordinances or parts of ordinances are hereby specifically repealed:

1. Ordinance 154 of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York and all amendments thereto.

ARTICLE XXXII

EFFECT OF LOCAL LAW

Section 320. Constitutionality. If any part or parts of this local law are for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this local law.

Section 321. Time to take effect

- (a) This local law shall take effect from and after the 6th day of June, 1977, except those parts, if any, which are subject to approval under Section 1684 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.
- (b) Any part or parts of this local law which are subject to approval under Section 1684 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law and Section 46 of the Highway Law of the State of New York shall take effect from and after the day on which approval in writing is received from the New York State Department of Transportation.


