Local Law No. 2 of the year 19 78

A local law Relating to Salaries for Trustees and Village Justice of the Village of Watkins Glen (Insert title)

Be it enacted by the [Name of Legislative Body] of the County City Town Village of as follows:

WHEREAS, by Local Law #3 of the year 1975, the annual salary for Village Trustees was established at \$1200, and

WHEREAS, by proper Resolution adopted at a regular meeting of the Village Board on April 19, 1976, the annual salary of Village Trustees was reduced to \$1,050, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire that the annual salary of the Village Trustees be re-established at \$1,200, and

WHEREAS, it is also the desire of the Board that the annual salary of Village Justice be established at \$4,635.,

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Watkins Glen as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Local Law shall be known as the law establishing the salaries for the Trustees and Village Justice of the Village of Watkins Glen.

SECTION 2. - ANNUAL SALARIES ESTABLISHED - Beginning with the official year beginning June 1, 1978, the annual salary of each of the Trustees of said Village shall be \$1,200.

SECTION 3 - VILLAGE JUSTICE ANNUAL SALARY ESTABLISHED - Beginning with the official year on June 1, 1978, the annual salary of the Village Justice of the Village of Watkins Glen shall be \$4,635.

SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE - This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Village Clerk, the Secretary of State and the State Comptroller as provided by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law but such filing shall not be made until forty-five days after its adoption by the Board of Trustees unless within such time a valid petition as required by Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law is filed with the Village Clerk protesting the adoption of this local law, in which event this local

law shall not be so filed or not take effect until after the approval of the qualified electors of this Village voting on this local law at a special or general election as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.

SECTION 5. This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum.

SECTION 6. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
