Local Law No. 1 of the year 1981

A local law AMENDING DOG ORDINANCE #164

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

First. That Dog Ordinance #164 of the Village of Watkins Glen be amended by the change of Section I therein to read as hereinafter provided and by the addition of a new Section XI thereof which shall read as hereinafter provided.

Second. That Section I of the Dog Ordinance #164 shall be and the same hereby is amended by the deletion therefrom of the phrase "...or by accompaniment and control of the owner or other responsible person" and that from and hereafter Section I shall read as follows:

SECTION I. RUNNING AT LARGE PROHIBITED. All dogs, while off the owner's premises, are to be restrained by a leash.

Third. A new Section entitled Section XI is hereby added to Dog Ordinance #164 and shall read as follows:

SECTION XI. It is the responsibility of all dog owners to prevent their dog from using property, other than their own property, for purposes of defecation.

If a dog does use property for defecation purposes, other than property that is owned or leased by the dog's owner, the owner must provide for the immediate clean-up and removal of excrement (feces).

These rules apply, whether the dog is under the immediate control of its owner or is running at large in violation of other provisions of the dog ordinance.

Failure to prevent ones dog from such use of others property or to clean up and remove the excrement will be a violation of the Dog Ordinance, Village Ordinance #164 and will constitute disorderly conduct.
