

3. On the west side of Franklin Street from the south curb line of Eighth St. to a point 62' southerly therefrom.

5. Article X, Section 104, Stopping Prohibited in Designated Locations, Section (a)(5) is hereby repealed.

6. Article X, Section 105, Parking Time Limited in Designated Locations, as amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1983 and Local Law No. 1 of 1985, is hereby amended by the following subdivisions 3 and 4 to Article X, Section 105(c), the parking of vehicles for a period longer than fifteen (15) minutes:

3. On the west side of Franklin Street between a point 41 feet northerly from the north curb line of Pine St. and a point 62 feet southerly from the south curb line of Eighth St.
4. On the east side of Franklin Street between a point 42 feet northerly from the north curb line of Ninth St. and a point 31 feet southerly from the south curb line of Eighth St.

7. Article VIII, Section 80, Stop and Yield Intersection, is hereby amended to designate the following additional two stop intersections and to authorize the placement of stop signs on entrances thereto as indicated:

<u>Intersection of</u>	<u>With Stop Sign On</u>	<u>Entrance(s)</u>
Partition Street	North Glen Avenue	North & South

8. Article X, Section 102, Parking Prohibited in Designated Locations, is hereby amended by the addition of Subdivisions (a) 19, 20 and 21 to read as follows:

19. On the south side of Twelfth Street from a point 20 feet easterly of the east curb line of Decatur Street to a point 20 feet westerly of the west curb line of South Porter Street.
20. On the south side of Twelfth Street from a point 20 feet easterly of the east curb line of South Porter Street to a point 20 feet westerly of the west curb line of south Perry Street.
21. On the north side of Twelfth Street from a point 20 feet easterly of the east curb line of South Porter Street to a point 20 feet westerly of the west curb line of South Perry Street.
