The four inch water main on this street in poor condition and should be considered for replacement. New water tank at state park has been pumping water through a meter previously unknown to department has now been identified and all information taken including 1,116,000 gallons of "lost" water. We believe there may be other "lost" water. Looking into. Pressure valve replacement by same manufacturer extremely expensive. 2 rebuild kits may work for us in short term, still looking at other options and prices. Discussed a gate and fence repair at the top of Second St. with Terry.
