A local law to amend Village Ordinance No. 131, The Parking Meter Ordinance

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

BE IT RESOLVED that Village Ordinance No. 131, the Parking Meter Ordinance, is hereby amended by the deletion of part of Section 2 thereof, wherein it provides that portions of the east and west sides of Franklin Street are in the parking meter zones and further, where it provides that portions of the north and south sides of Fourth Street are in the parking meter zones, and it is further

RESOLVED that from and after the effective date of this Local Law, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 131 shall read as follows:

"SECTION 2. PARKING METER ZONES. The following parking meter zones on streets in the Village of Watkins Glen are hereby designated and established: The north and south sides of First, Second, Third, Fifth and Sixth Streets between Franklin and Decatur Streets.

"And from time to time hereafter, as traffic conditions require, on such other and additional streets, avenues and parking fields as are selected by resolution of the Village of Watkins Glen, New York, for the location of such zones."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Village Ordinance No. 131 be further amended by the modification of Section 5 (b) as it relates to metered parking on Franklin or Fourth Street by the elimination of any reference to metered parking on said streets, and be it further

RESOLVED that from and after the effective date of this amendment, Section 5 (b) of Village Ordinance No. 131 shall read as follows:

"SECTION 5. PARKING TIME LIMITS...

(b) The parking or standing of vehicles during the time that parking meters shall be operated in the parking meter zones as provided for in the preceding paragraph "(a)" is hereby prohibited for a period of longer than 2 hours in all parking meter spaces on streets or in the parking meter zones."

This local law shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and proper filing with the State Comptroller and Secretary of State.
