A local law Allowing Sunday Sporting Events

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

Village as follows:

First: It shall be lawful to conduct, witness, participate or engage in any form of public sports, exercises, or shows which are conducted or engaged in primarily for the entertainment of spectators, on the first day of the week after 5 minutes past one o'clock in the afternoon within the Village of Watkins Glen.

Second: The public may be invited to witness such sports, exercises, or shows and an admission fee may be charged for admission to such event.

Third: Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to prohibit private sports, games, or recreational activities which are engaged in primarily for the personal enjoyment, recreation and health of the participants, on the first day of the week, conducted in a manner which does not constitute a serious interruption of the repose or religious liberties of the community.

Fourth: This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

4. (Subject to permissive referendum, and final adoption because no valid petition filed requesting referendum.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the County City of was duly passed by the (Name of Legislative Body) on 19 not disapproved and was approved by the Elective Chief Executive Officer * repassed after disapproval on 19. Such local law being subject to a permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum having been filed, said local law was deemed duly adopted on 19, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village or the supervisor of a town, where such officer is vested with power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the City of having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of § 36 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the special election held on 19 became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. of 19 of the County of, State of New York, having been submitted to the Electors at the General Election of November, 19, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of Section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and of a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
