SECOND. Article X, Section 103 (a) (49) is hereby amended to prohibit standing on the north side of Fourth Street between a point 80 feet westerly from the west curb line of Perry Street and a point 80 feet easterly from the east curb line of Perry Street.

 $\overline{\text{THIRD}}.$ Article X, Section 103 (a) prohibiting standing, is hereby amended to add the following subsection

71. On the south side of Fourth Street between Magee Street and a point 50 feet west of the west curb line of Magee Street and between a point 80 feet westerly from the west curb line of Perry Street and a point 50 feet east of the east curb line of Perry Street.

FOURTH: Article X, Section 105 (6) prohibiting parking for a period longer than two (2) hours, is hereby amended to add the following subsections:

- 8. On the south side of Fourth Street between a point 50 feet west of the west curb line of Magee Street and 50 feet east of the east curb line of Perry Street.
- 9. In the Municipal Parking lot situated east of Franklin Street between Fourth and Fifth Streets.
- 10. In the Municipal Parking lot situated east of Franklin Street on the north side of Third Street.
