Subsection 3.2 of Section 3.0 (General Provisions) of the Flood Damage Prevention Local Law of the Village of Watkins Glen, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.2 BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD

The areas of special flood hazard have been identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in a scientific and engineering report entitled "Flood Insurance Study Village of Watkins Glen, New York, Schuyler County" dated January, 1978 with Flood Insurance Rate Maps enumerated on Map Index No. 360570 0001B dated July 17, 1978 and with accompanying Flood Boundary and Floodway Maps enumerated on Map Index No. 360570 0001B dated July 17, 1978.

The above documents are, hereby, adopted and declared to be a part of this local law and are filed at the Municipal Building, 303 N. Franklin Street, Watkins Glen, New York.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.




