LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2016

A Local Law entitled Exception to Competitive Bidding

Be it enacted by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the

Village of Watkins Glen as follows:

A Local Law to authorize the use of a Best Value award methodology in the competitive bidding process, for purchase contracts (including contracts for service work, but excluding any purchase contracts necessary for the completion of a public works contract pursuant to Article 8 of the NYS Labor Law) in accordance with General Municipal Law ("GML") Sections 103(1), 103(16) and the NY Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 1. Applicability

The following specific procurement policy is intended to apply only to goods and services where the Village wishes to make procurements under GML Section 103(1) through the basis of best value and/or under GML Section 103(16) through the basis of best value and procurements let by other governmental entities, including the United States or any agency thereof, the State of New York and any political subdivision thereof, in a manner consistent with GML Section 103.

Section 2. Policy.

- (a) Many local governments have been approached by vendors offering goods and services under contracts, and in some cases, vendors have asserted that the contract falls within the exception in GML Section 103(1). Pursuant to GML Section 103(1) and the NY Municipal Home Rule Law, the following must be present in order for GML Section 103(1) to apply to specific contracts approved by the Village, which would otherwise be subject to public bidding, but for this Local Law:
 - 1. The contract must be a purchase contract (including contracts for service work, but excluding any purchase contracts necessary for the completion of a public works contract pursuant to article eight of the labor law.).
 - 2. The contract must have been let to the lowest responsible bidder or on the basis of best value in a manner consistent with this section.
 - 3. The contract must be consistent with GML Section 103.
- (b) Many local governments have been approached by vendors offering goods and services under other government contracts, and in some cases, vendors have asserted that the contract falls within the exception in GML Section 103(16). Pursuant to GML Section 103(16) and the NY Municipal Home Rule Law, the following must be present in order for GML Section 103(16) to apply to specific contracts approved by the Village, which would otherwise be subject to public bidding, but for this Local Law:

- 1. The contract must be let by the United States or any agency thereof, the State of New York or any political subdivision or district therein.
- 2. The contract must have been made available for use by other governmental entities.
- 3. The contract must have been let to the lowest responsible bidder or on the basis of best value in a manner consistent with this section.
- 4. The contract must be consistent with GML Section 103.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State.
