A variance request cannot be submitted by anyone other than the property owner and there are specific guidelines for granting a variance; they should not be granted lightly. Melinda Beheydt is not the owner of 806 N Decatur Street and therefore, should not be the person applying for said variance. Colleen Chavchavadze made the motion to deny the requested use variance. David Hertel seconded the motion. The Board then voted on the motion and all were in favor. Motion Carried.
